Inland Vessels and Inland Watercrafts

General information

If under A and B and/or a price category a Port User is eligible for several discounts/rebates, the discounts/rebates will be calculated based on the relevant subtotal in the sequence as set forth in 2.1.3 Port GTC.
In so far as the Schedule of Fees and Charges provides for tariffs to be chosen for a calendar quarter or calendar year, such tariffs cover the combined fee up until the end of the calendar quarter or calendar year started.

A. Combined Fee

General information

Depending on the price category, intensity of use and type of watercraft different combined fees are charged for the use of the Port of Hamburg in accordance with this Schedule of Fees and Charges.

The notification rules defined in 4.1 Special Terms and Conditions applicable to Inland Shipping apply.
Non-compliance entails penalties and processing fees as set forth in item C of this Schedule of Fees and Charges.

The combined fee does not cover the use of generally approved HPA-berths as permanent berths or permanent overnight berths. The combined fee and/or the extended HPA-berth fee also do not cover the use of CGH (Cruise Gate Hamburg GmbH)-operated facilities.

M Unless the passenger ship, cargo vessel or other watercraft is 100% exempted a minimum fee as defined in 2.1.1 Port GTC is due of € / call **42.29**

A.2. Cargo vessels and other watercrafts

General information

Cap tugs For self-propelled vessels that are assessed based on the power of their main engine (kW) (e.g. push boats / tugboats) no combined fee is payable for the engine power in excess of 900 kW.

B. Extended HPA-berth fee

General information: Port Users can extend the scope of use of the berths operated but not assigned by the HPA by paying the extended HPA-berth fee tariff as defined in 2.2 and 4.1.5 Special Terms and Conditions applicable to Inland Shipping

Level 1 applies to the period of use from the first calendar day or part thereof to the 10th calendar day or part thereof

Level 2 applies to the period of use from the 11th calendar day or part thereof onwards

The time at the berth is determined as set out in 2.2. Special Terms and Conditions applicable to Inland Shipping.

Under the flex tariff and the saver tariff the fee levels apply per each watercraft and/or watercraft convoy; under the city tariff and the tariff applicable to passenger watercrafts they are calculated per each watercraft.

3. Examples of a breach of the duty to notify

a) Minor breach of the duty to notify

- Port User holds a valid combined-fee for the inland vessel (e.g. annual fee), notice of departure from the port area **received late**
- Port User holds a valid combined-fee for the inland vessel (e.g. annual fee), notice of departure from the port area **not submitted**
- Port User has not declared at all or not declared correctly on the ELBA portal the HPA-berths used by the inland vessel

b) Serious breach of the duty to notify

- Port User has not chosen a valid tariff, transmits notice of arrival **without information** concerning the desired **tariff** (tariff period of validity/validation date)
- Port User **has not** submitted any **notice**; is/was in the area **without** holding a **valid tariff**
- Port User has a valid City tariff or Saver tariff for the inland vessel, however, the vessel uses HPA-berths WITH land access although the Port User **has not applied for** extended HPA-berth fees (eALG) to cover the additional scope of use.
